

Grouse hunting in Jokkmokk

– Autumn hunt at the Arctic Circle



Come with us for some exciting grouse hunting in the heart of the forestland, 20 km south of Jokkmokk and a stone's throw from the Arctic Circle. The main species are capercaillie, black grouse and hazel grouse. We pursue traditional Norrbotten bird-hunting, stalking, luring and with a tree-baying dog, where you the hunting guest are always at the centre of things. We offer you exclusive access to hunting grounds empty of other hunters. We also offer you experienced guides, well trained dogs and pleasant cabin accommodation just outside Jokkmokk.

Day 1: Guests arrive at Lenatorp in Jokkmokk Municipality and check in, then we visit the shooting range to set our weapons. Briefing and run-through of the day's hunting.

Day 2: After a hearty breakfast we make for the hunting grounds. The guest stays with the dog-handler/ hunting guide. We take a break during the day for meals served outdoors.

Day 3: See programme Day 2.

Day 4: Naturally, we start the day with a hearty breakfast. We then hunt until lunchtime. We gather to round off and travel home.
